If you read all *four* of the books listed, you will earn **double bonus points**: two perfect scores of 100 on any two quizzes of your choice. Bring your books to class in September when we return so we can share our summer adventures with classmates.

You can find your books in your local library, your local bookstore, or choose to read on an eReader. If you would like to use an audiobook to accompany your summer reading choices, please make sure you are following along with the text version as well.
