**Lower School Supply List**  
**Grades EC - 5**  
**2020-2021**

During the 2020-21 school year, we will be limiting the number of supplies that are shared between students. Each student should bring their own set of the following materials. Individual supplies are not to be shared between students. *When back-to-school shopping, have your child choose items (lunch box, water bottle, backpack, pencils, headphones) they can easily identify.*

**Updates to list highlighted in green**

**All Students**

- Face masks (enough to wash and wear a clean mask to school every day, with an extra mask to keep in backpack)
- Weather-resistant backpack with a relatively waterproof bottom because it may be sitting on the ground outdoors
- A lunch box that is easy to clean/wipe down and students are able to open themselves. *Microwaves will not be available to heat up lunches this year.*
- A reusable water bottle
- Small personal hand sanitizer (*gloves optional*)
- Small pack of tissues
- Seasonal gear -- certain activities will be outdoors, rain or shine, to provide mask and movement breaks every day. *Please make sure students are prepared with appropriate outdoor gear each day. We highly recommend leaving a set at school.*
  - Fall/spring: Boots, rain coat, sun hat or cap
  - Winter: Warm jacket, hat, gloves, scarf, snow pants
- Bug spray and sunscreen
- **Now Required: Outdoor camp chair.** This may be left at school but should be weatherproof so it could be stored outdoors. Seat should be light and foldable for easy transport and storage. The height of the seat does not impact participation in class because students will be spread out. (Please note that, since spending this much outdoor time is a new experience for most students, they may change their minds about what type of seating they prefer as they try different products.) Here are a few optional accessories that may make the outdoors more comfortable:

- *Optional:* Waterproof picnic blanket (alternative to a camp chair for young students)
- *Optional:* Canopy, sun shade, or small personal umbrella that can be clipped to a chair (no popup tents)
- *Optional:* Lap desk or surface for writing

### Early Childhood

- Extra masks to be kept at school
- All-natural fragrance-free wipes
- Clothing (a few pairs of underwear and socks, shirt, pants, and a sweatshirt)
- Small water-resistant backpack to be used outdoors
- Small towel or blanket to sit on outside which will fit easily inside the backpack

For those who stay for extended day:

- **Small** pillow and **small** blanket, or an all-in-one "nap mat."
- **Small** stuffed animal (if desired)

### Kindergarten

- 1 set of washable markers
- 1 small box of crayons
- 1 pair Fiskars children's scissors
- 2 pencils
- 1 small manual pencil sharpener
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 eraser
- Pencil box (approx. size 13" x 7" x 4" or smaller) that all items (excluding lunch box, water bottle, and headphones) can fit into

- Wired headphones for computer use (suggestion: Maxell 190318 or similar, preferably with a straight connection)

### **Grade One**

- 1 pack of #2 pencils
- 1 personal pencil sharpener (non-electric)
- 1 eraser
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pack of markers
- Dry-erase markers (4 pack)
- 1 clipboard
- 1 pair Fiskars children's scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 folders with two pockets
- Small, non-locking pencil box to hold desk supplies
- Mac-compatible earbuds/headphones

### **Grade Two**

- 2 folders with two pockets
- 2 composition books (100 sheets)
- 1 clipboard
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 white 1" binder
- 1 small pack of colored pencils
- 12 pencils
- Scissors
- 2 highlighters
- 2 green pens
- Pencil box (no taller than 3½ inches, no longer than 12 inches) to store supplies
- Mac-compatible earbuds/headphones

### **Grade Three**

- 1 three-subject notebook
- 2 one-subject notebooks
- 2 folders with inside pockets
- Set of markers
- Set of colored pencils
- Scissors

- Glue sticks
- Pencils with erasers
- Pencil box that fits markers, pencils, glue sticks, scissors (all supplies labeled in a Ziplock bag with name if not in pencil box)
- Mac-compatible earbuds/headphones

### **Grade Four**

- 1 pkg. thin markers
- 1 pkg. of 24 colored pencils
- 1 pkg. of #2 pencils
- Scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 sturdy folder with pockets
- A small box to store supplies (no more than 9")
- A set of Mac-compatible earbuds/headphones

### **Grade Five**

- Two 1" three-ring binders
- 1 clipboard
- 1 package of pencils
- Scissors
- 2 pads of 3x3 inch yellow post-it notes (non-accordion style)
- 4 pack of assorted color highlighters
- 1 small package of thin whiteboard markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box of colored pencils
- A small box to store supplies (something you could bring outside or fit in your backpack)
- A pair of small Mac-compatible wired headphones/earbuds
- A backpack that fits your two classroom binders and has a laptop sleeve (a separate laptop sleeve is fine as long as the laptop and binders can still fit in the backpack)
- **For specials:** two 1" three-ring binders with internal pockets (for Art and Music, to be used through eighth grade)
