

## CONSENT TO APPLY SUNSCREEN AND INSECT REPELLENT

Friends Academy Summer Program is dedicated to children's daily sun protection. It is our intent to provide your child with the best sun protection possible during camp hours and while they are under our supervision. For additional protection from the sun's harmful rays, please encourage your child to wear a hat, sunglasses and appropriate clothing. Campers should arrive with sunscreen and insect repellent already applied. Insect repellent should contain deet, as that is required to defend against ticks and mosquitoes that live within our woods. Camp counselors will reapply mid day if necessary.

### Important Sun Facts for Parents

- People of all skin colors get skin cancer. More than 3.5 million skin cancers in more than 2 million people are diagnosed annually
- Skin cancer is the most common cancer in the United States. 1 in 5 Americans develop a type of skin cancer in their lifetime
- Melanoma skin cancer can be deadly. One american dies of skin cancer every hour
- Most skin cancers are caused by overexposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays, which sunscreen protects against
- We get 80% of our lifetime sun exposure by the age of 18 years old.
- Even 1 severe sunburn in childhood can double the risk of developing melanoma later in later
